

EDGEWOOD BAND BOOSTERS ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION

Article 1 Name

The name of this organization shall be “The Edgewood Band Boosters Association”.

Article 2 Objectives

Section 1

To arouse and maintain an enthusiastic interest in the various phases of the instrumental music departments of the Edgewood Schools to include: all instrumental ensembles, marching band, color guard and winter guard.

Section 2

To lend all possible support, both moral and financial, to the general instrumental music programs in the Edgewood School District.

Section 3

To cooperate with those in charge of the instrumental music departments, those dealing with color guard and the Board of Education to the end that this music department be brought up and kept to the highest possible degree of quality and efficiency. To build and maintain an organization, which will promote the general activities of the instrumental music departments at all, levels.

Article 3 Membership

The membership of the Association shall be limited. Anyone interested in the progress and development of the instrumental music department and color guard of the Edgewood School District is eligible for membership. Students of the Edgewood School District are not eligible. Parents of students in the above groups and anyone else wishing to be a “voting member” must attend two meetings. Upon fulfillment of these requirements, that person shall be considered a “voting member” and shall have voting privileges.

Article 4 Elected Officers

The elected officers of this group shall be President, President-elect, Secretary, Treasury Department and Treasurer-elect. The band directors and all associated staff, the superintendent and the high school principal or his designee shall be officer's ex-officio. The duties shall be those usually developing on such office and as designed in the by-laws. The President-elect and Treasurer-elect will succeed to the office of the president and Treasury Department.

EXECUTIVE BOARD: The Executive Board shall be composed of the officers, the officer's ex-officio and the immediate past president of the Association. The Executive Board shall meet monthly prior to the general membership meeting to determine the agenda for said meeting.

Article 5 Election of Officers

The President prior to the April Meeting shall appoint a Nomination Committee Chairman. Said Chairperson shall select committee members as he/she feels necessary in order to compile a list of nominees to be submitted to the executive board at their April meeting. The nominating committee shall present the nominees to the membership at the May meeting at which time nominations from the floor will also be accepted. Nominations will be closed at the end of the April meeting in order to allow preparation of a printed ballot. Write-in votes will be accepted. Ballots are to be distributed at the May meeting. Active member will vote, the ex-officio officers will tally the ballots, and the results shall be announced prior to the closing of the meeting. Any tie vote shall require a run off election by ballot as outlined above. For anyone to be eligible for an office, he/she must have a child in the band for the year they serve.

Article 6 Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Association, any proceeds or assets of the Association shall be delivered to the Board of Education, Edgewood School District.
